Report on the International Day of Light (May 16, 2024)

On May 16, 2024, the EPAC-UAC Chapter of Optica celebrated the International Day of Light (IDL) with a diverse and enriching program. The day brought together participants with a passion for the science of light, and was held in a friendly and dynamic atmosphere.

The day began with a warm welcome for participants. The organizers made sure that everyone was comfortably seated, ready to take part in the planned activities. Shortly afterwards, the Director of EPAC, Professor Guy ALITONOU or his representative, took the floor to welcome everyone. His speech, followed by that of the Head of the Computer Engineering and Telecommunications Department (GIT), Dr Tahirou DJARA.
